MEDICAL

In order for your child to receive medical and/or dental care in West Virginia, payment is required at the time of service. Therefore, we must receive the following information to provide your child with the appropriate medical or dental treatment.

We must have a credit card number for our dentists and pharmacists. You can use any credit card you want, but Visa/MasterCard is preferred as this is used the most in the West Virginia/Virginia area. Please include the name that appears on credit card as well as the expiration date. If you choose not to use a credit card (or you don't have one), then we strongly urge you to deposit additional money into your child's spending account to cover any out-of-pocket medical expenses. As stated on the application, we do not cover medical or dental expenses. Also, if you do not submit a copy of your prescription card and we are unable to contact you, we will fill the prescription without the card. It will not become our responsibility to get you reimbursed for the prescription. Please submit this form even if you think your child will not need medicine.

If you have a prescription card for us to use, we must have the following information: name of insured, name of insurance company, plan number and name that appears on the card. Please make a copy of the prescription card (both front and back) and submit it to us with this form.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION

At Timber Ridge, we look at each new camper as a member of our summer family. Because there are, at times, only a few weeks to really get to know your child, we must never lose sight of the tremendous responsibility to learn about each child as quickly as possible. While such things as personality differences and behavioral traits will continue to surface throughout the summer, certain things such as a child's allergy to medication cannot afford a day's wait. At Timber Ridge, we rely on the written word. Many of those words must initially come from you.

Due to the obvious importance of your child's medical history, we find it necessary to make it mandatory that before any child be permitted at Timber Ridge our office must first have a current completed health form on file. If you don't turn in your medical form, your child will not be permitted to come to camp.

IMPORTANT: PLEASE MAKE AN APPOINTMENT WITH YOUR PEDIATRICIAN TODAY TO AVOID THE SPRING RUSH. TRY TO SCHEDULE THE PHYSICAL BY MAY 30TH AT THE LATEST.

REMINDER - Camp is not responsible for any out-of-camp medical expenses or prescription medications. If you will supply us with your medical insurance (the form on page 3) we will be happy to submit this on your behalf at the time of service, but you are ultimately responsible.

OPTIONAL TRIPS

Our camp tuition is all-inclusive. We feel we offer a complete camping experience that covers a wide range of activities and trips such as roller-skating, amusement parks, backpacking, bike trips and rock climbing. However, there are many other exciting things in our area that the children may want to take advantage of that are not part of the camp tuition and do involve extra costs. In order to enhance what we think is already a great program, we are offering these programs to campers for an additional fee. Please keep in mind these trips are optional and any camper will have a great summer experience without opting for them. Listed below are the extra trips available and their costs. If you would like to reserve a trip for your child, please complete the form on the following page and return it with your check by May 20th to the camp office. Due to reservation restrictions, we will not be able to add campers once camp has started. Please notice there are age limitations on certain trips. Unfortunately, due to time constraints second session campers may not be able to go on all of these trips.

Trip 1	Gettysburg– Full & First Sessions	\$85
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Available to all Campers. Timber Ridge will be taking a tour of the Battle of Gettysburg. The Battle of Gettysburg was a turning point in the Civil War, the Union victory that ended General Robert E. Lee's second and most ambitious invasion of the North. Often referred to as the "High Water Mark of the Rebellion", Gettysburg was the war's bloodiest battle with 51,000 casualties. It was also the inspiration for President Abraham Lincoln's immortal "Gettysburg Address". We will begin our visit to the park at the Gettysburg National Military Park Museum and Visitor Center with its 22,000 square-foot museum gallery of interactive programs, multi-media presentations, and exhibits featuring relics from one of the largest museum collections in America. We will then begin our guided tour of one of the greatest battlefields on American soil. Visiting the Confederate high water mark, the Gettysburg National Cemetery, the David Willis House and many other treasures the battle field has to offer. After our tour we will stop by the legendary General Pickett's Buffet for dinner before returning to camp.

Trip 2	Harpers Ferry – Full & Second Sessions	\$70
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Available to all Campers. Harpers Ferry, just 45 minutes from camp is a historic community, at the confluence of the Potomac and Shenandoah rivers. We will stroll the picturesque streets, visit exhibits and museums, and hike the trails and battlefields. This is a place where living history is brought back to life. You will get a chance to see the view from Jefferson Rock, which Thomas Jefferson described as the most beautiful place in America. Harpers Ferry has had many important roles in history it was once a major Industrial town, railroad and river junction. It later hosted John Brown's raid, a major event leading up to the outbreak of the American Civil War. Harpers Ferry and the heights surrounding felt the rash of many major and minor battles of the Civil War. Today it is one of the most visited spots on the east coast, with a little piece of history from many decades, bike and Hiking trails, and amazing scenic overlooks. On the way back to camp we will stop at Golden Corral for a wonderful dinner.

Trip 3	Golfing – All Sessions	\$350 For 3 Sessions
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All campers who are competent enough golfers to play competitively on an 18-hole golf course are eligible for an entire morning or afternoon on the links at Rock Harbor Golf Course. Each foursome includes a counselor and uses a golf cart (for counselor operation only). Clubs are provided for a cost, but campers are welcome to bring their own. Full-session campers can do a maximum of six trips and half-session campers can do a maximum of three trips. Rental of golf clubs is an extra cost of \$20. Pull carts are available at a cost of \$5 as the golf club bag is very large and can be hard to carry.

Trip 4

Paintball – Full, First & Second Sessions

\$80

All current 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 10th graders may choose to go on our paintball adventure. During this all inclusive trip we will supply everything needed to experience thrill of paintball at one of the best facilities in Virginia. For over two hours, Timber Ridge campers will have access to all of the paintball fields. After we finish an awesome day of paintball, we will fill up at the Golden Corral for an all you can eat delicious meal and will then head back to camp.
